



SECURITY CAMERAS FOR PENINSULA RESIDENTS

With recent car break ins, more than 20 in total reported, homeowners are looking for solutions. Moreover, if we employ security interventions collectively, we are more secure as a community. We hope that this communication from the Peninsula Tech Committee is helpful.

There are two general approaches to take: (1) wireless security cameras and (2) doorbell options. Doorbells are the simplest, easiest to use and install and for the most part the least expensive. Cameras are also a great way to keep an eye on your home and spot potential trouble. Features for cameras that we recommend are night vision, high-definition video [minimum 2K – prefer 4K], voice control via digital assistants like Alexa, two-way audio, smart phone alerts and battery operated or wired.

Below we have put together several camera and doorbell options, from high end to low end and their Amazon ratings. To begin, you should identify WHY YOU WANT a security system & match quality and features to what you need.

The first part of the chart summarizes CAMERAS – almost all of these manufacturers offer full security systems with alarms, door/window alerts and very integrated software. Some may simply want to consider a RING DOORBELL which affords you visibility/security at your front door.

The camera options are DIY models (listed in no particular order) – if you want a whole house security system you may want to call a professional (but it will have a setup fee and a hefty monthly charge from \$50 to \$100/month depending on vendor & equipment features). That is why it is so important to write down what you really want when choosing cameras.

As one example, one individual wanted to have a quality video system capable of flexible monitoring features to turn on alerts [recordings due to movement] with ability to see, save and forward [email or text] those alerts. This person wanted to get a system that could handle 5 cameras as there are 4 inside facing entrance points and one over the front door for deliveries & viewing of cars. Also, an extended battery life span and an outdoor camera option. This person did not want to pay for storage and only needed 30 days [even one week will do]. They did not require sirens or monitoring by police nor pan & tilt functionality. Another individual simply wanted visibility at their entrance and far corner of their garage. Each of us will be different in our needs.

Today you will see 2K or 4K video, two-way audio as standards in all models. Prices range from \$39 to \$150 for a camera. If you only need to watch a few doors with an indoor camera the low-end models are perfect and inexpensive. Getting alerts on your phone gives you a sense of security and ability to take action [via phone call] as the event is occurring.

Please write down your needs, do your research, call one of Tech Club members if you do not understand something or are down to two choices and can't decide.

Additional Notes: (1) Just because your house is safer doesn't mean the footage these streaming video cameras collect is necessarily safe—or even private. Data security and data privacy is a good idea. (2) These

camera devices have different capabilities with regard to their ability to record and store footage. This does present some challenges because the different device brands don't handle these aspects the same way. Installing a camera device but not being able to access its video footage, should there be a need like what recently took place, kind of defeats the purpose of having it. So do make sure that you are able to access the footage and (3) bear in mind with regard to Ring doorbell, you will be constrained by the location of your current doorbell and the "visibility" that this location affords for surveillance. Not a deal breaker but something to keep in mind.
